The Samareitikon (Greek: τὸ Σαμαρειτικὸν) is the name given to the Greek translation of the Samaritan Pentateuch. The Samareitikon is obtained only from marginal notes in other manuscripts and quotations in Origen. As S. Kohn has shown, these passages show dependencies on the Samaritan Targum.
